William Lyons Esquire, Register for the Probate of Wills and granting Letters of Administration, in and for the said County of Cumberland, in the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. To John Hunter Administrator of William Hunter Deceased GREETING.

WHEREAS the said William Hunter lately died intestate (as is affirmed) having whilst he lived, and at the time of his decease, divers goods and chattles, rights and credits within the said County, by means whereof the full disposition and power of granting Letters of Administration thereof is manifestly known to belong to me: I therefore desiring that the goods and chattles, rights and credits which where of the said deceased, may be well and truly Administrated, converted and disposed of according to Law. Do hereby grant unto you the said John Hunter (in whose fidelity this behalf I very much confide) full power by the tenor of these Presents, to Administer the goods and chattles, rights and credits, which were of the said deceased, within the said County; as also to ask, collect, levy, recover and receive the credits whatsoever of the said deceased, which at the time of his death were owing or did any way belong to him, and to pay the debts in which the said deceased stood obliged, so far forth as the said goods and chattles, rights and credits will extend, according to their rate and order of Law; especially, of well and truly administering the goods and chattles, rights and credits, which were of the said deceased, and making a true and perfect inventory and conscionable appraisement thereof, and exhibiting the same into the Register's Office in the borough of Carlisle, on or before the eighteenth day of September next ensuing, and also a just and true account, calculation and reckoning, of your Administration, upon your solemn oath to render at or before the eighteenth day of August in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty three or when thereunto lawfully required.

And I do by these presents ordain constitute and depute you the said John Hunter Administrator of all and singular the goods and chattles, rights and credits, which were of the said deceased within the limits aforesaid, saving harmless and forever indemnifying me and all other Officers against all persons, by reason of your Administration aforesaid, and saving all others their rights &c.
