 Johnston of the Borough of Carlisle in the County of
 Cumberland and State of Pennsylvania formerly
 a private in Captain Campbell's Company of the
 fourth Regiment of the Pennsylvania Line Commanded
 by Genl Butler All by these presents bind
 take and appoint General William Irvine of the
 Borough of Carlisle aforesaid and John Keeble
 Gentlemen of the City of Philadelphia my True and
 Lawful Attorneys in my Name and for my Use to
 ask Damages and Recovers from the Common Wealth
 of Pennsylvania a Patent for the Donation Land
 promised me by the said Common Wealth in Consider
 ation of my Services as a Soldier in the late War
 with Great Britain and further to do hereby
 empower my said Attorneys to act jointly or
 Separately in the Premises; and as by these pre
 sents and Confirm whatev^{er} my said Attorneys
 either of them shall Lawfully do in the Premises
 and in case any other Person claims the said Land
 by Virtue of any pretended Right I do empower
 my said Attorneys or either of them to enter and
 answer Comaats and to do every act and thing
 that may be Lawful for the Recovery of the said Land
 in as full and Effectual a manner as I myself
 do could I personally present In Witness
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
 seal this 10th day of July 1792
