 Rangers in the late war as a Private and was
 thereby and in Pursuance of an Act of Assembly
 for that Purpose entitled to Receive from the
 Commonwealth of Pennsylvania the Quantity
 of Two hundred Acres of Land as a Donation for
 his Services Now know ye that I Elizabeth
 Jones the Widdow of the said John William Jones
 for a valuable Consideration to me in hand paid
 by George Jones the Receipt whereof I do hereby
 acknowledge have granted bargained and sold
 the aforesaid tract of Land to the said George
 Jones his heirs and assigns forever with full
 power to ask demands and receive the same from
 this Commonwealth in the same full and
 ample manners as I might or could do was
 I personally present. In Testimony whereof
 I have hereunto set my hand and affixed my
 Seal this Thursday of April in the Year
 of our Lords one thousand seven hundred and
 ninety Six
