Before me the Subscriber one of the Associate Judges of the Court of Common Pleas in and for the County aforesaid, personally appeared Christian Nagel of Hopewell Township in the County of Bedford, who being duly sworn upon the Holy Evangelists of Almighty God did depose and say That he is for these many years past well and intimately acquainted with Ezechiel Sankey, and that to his Depoiments certain Knowledge the said Ezechiel Sankey served as a private Soldier in Captain John Christy's Company of the third Pennsylvania Regiment commanded by Colonel Richard Butler in the Service of the United States during the late Revolutionary War, and that he was enlisted for and continued in the Service aforesaid during and until the End of the said War, and that he obtained his Discharge from the Service on or about the 19. Day of June 1783.

And this Depoiment further saith that there was no other Person of the Name of Ezechiel Sankey but the above named Ezechiel Sankey in the Regiment aforesaid, and that the present applicant Ezechiel Sankey, is the same individual person mentioned in the above Depoiments. And further this Depoiment saith not.
