 for me and in my Name Place and stead, to Repair to
 the Office where the Donation Lands is drawn in the City
 of Philadelphia destined for the Officers & Soldiers of the said
 late Pennsylvania Line, And for me and in my Name, Place
 and stead to draw such Lands as the Commonwealth of Pennsyl-
 vania has Assigned for me as a Sergeant late belonging to the
 said Pennsylvania Line, And Generally to do and perform
 all and every such other Matter Act or Thing whatsoever which
 shall or may be needful and necessary to be done & performed
 concerning the Premises, Ratifying and confirming whatsoever
 my said Attorney shall or may lawfully do in and about the
 same. In Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and
 Seal the 9th Day of December Anno Domini 1786.
