Madison Tennessee before the sealing and delivery hereof, the receipt whereof
I do hereby acknowledge, have and by these presents do grant, bargain sell assign re-
lease and confirm unto the said James Humphreys

and to his heirs and assigns forever all my estate, right, title interest use possession
property, claim and demand whatsoever, which I now have to all and singular the
lands, pay, arrears of pay, clothing, rations, gratuities, or other demands due
and owing to me from the United States, or from any particular State for my
services as aforesaid. TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the a-
foresaid premises unto the said James Humphreys with the appurtenances unto him the said

James Humphreys by nominate, constitute, and appoint him the said James Humphreys
his heirs and assigns my true and lawful Attorney irrevocable, to all, de-
mand, recover and receive of and from the United States, or from any particular
State, or from any person or persons acting by from or under their or any of their
authority, all and singular the said lands, pay, arrears of pay, rations, gratuities
and other demands whatsoever due and owing to me as aforesaid, and to re-
ceive and accept the same by grant or otherwise in his or their own name or names
and to his or their own proper use and behoof forever, and also to sign seal and
execute good and sufficient discharges for the same in due form of Law.

Justices of the Peace in and for said County of Sancaster
Thomas and being sworn according to Rule, testify that
he this defendant does hold opening at the house of James McCord
that a certain certain Room with certain beds and some into
the front Room, and after some conversation said down on
paper on a table, and immediately being called by the name
of being called in haste by spirit of James who was very ill
I put it into my pocket among other papers and so forth
