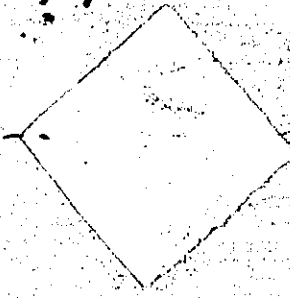


Know all men by these presents that I Peter
Tresler Esquire of Mackungy Township in the County of North
ampton for full value received do by these presents give grant
and confirm unto James Charra in Mackatony Township in
the County of Berks a certain Tract of one hundred acres of Land
to which Jacob McClean was entitled as a Donation from
the State of Pennsylvania for his services as a soldier in the
Colonel Harmers Regiment in the Pennsylvania Line of the
late Army of the United States (which Grant of Land was af-
signed and delivered to me by the said Jacob McClean on the
twenty three day of January Anno Domini 1788) To have and to
hold the said Tract of Land with its appurtenances unto the
said James Charra his heirs and assigns to his and their only
proper use benefit and behoof forever In Witness whereof
I hereunto set my hand and seal this eighteenth day of January
Anno Domini 1791
