pursue and follow such legal courses for the recovery  
Receiving and obtaining of the same as I myself  
Might or could do were I personally present and upon  
The receipt of the Acquittances and other sufficient  
Discharges for me and in my name to make Sign Seal  
And Deliver as also one or more Attorneys undertime  
To substitute or appoint and again at his pleasure  
To revoke and further to do perform and finish for  
me and in my name all and singular thing or thi-  
-ngs which shall or be necessary touching and  
Concerning my demands against said State as  
Fully thoroughly and entirely as I the said Thomas  
McLean in my own person ought or could do in  
And about the same making allowing and con-  
-forming whatsoever my said Attorney shall lawfully  
do or cause to be done in and about the execution  
Of the s<sup>d</sup> Demands by virtue of these presents in  
Witness hereof I have hereunto set my hand  
And Seal this sixteenth day of November 1786
