due and owing for and in consequence of services as aforesaid, and from  
the receipt of the whole or any part thereof, in due form of law, to exe-  
cute and deliver requisite and sufficient receipts, Releases and acquittances  
for the same, with power also an attorney or attorneys under him for  
the purpose aforesaid to make and substitute and to do and execute all  
lawful acts requisite for effecting the premises; as fully and effectually  
to all intents and purposes as if we might or could do by being  
personally present, and to have done the same, hereby satisfying  
and conforming all that our said Attorney or his substitute or
