 whatsoever in Law or Equity Touching and concerning the said Discharge for  
 me and in my Name as fully and in every Respect as I my self might or  
 could do were I personally Present at the doing thereof and Attorneys one  
 or more under him for the Purposes aforesaid to make and again at Pleasure  
 to Revoke, Ratifying and confirming, and by these Presents allowing whatsoever  
 my said Attorney shall in my name lawfully do or cause to be done in and  
 about the Premises by virtue of these Presents. In Witness whereof I have
