me in my name and to my Use to apply for and
obtain at the Secretary's Office of the State of Pennsylv-
ania, and at the War Office of the United States grants
or Patents of Land due to me from the State of Pennsylv-
ania and the United States and each or either of them
or to apply for the same at any other place or Office
that may be requisite to obtain the same And on a
Receipt thereof to give good acknowledgements and
discharge for the same And to do all lawful
requisite for effecting the Premises hereby ratifying
and confirming all that shall be done therein by
virtue hereof In Witness whereof I have hereunto set
my Hand and Seal at New York the twenty second
day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand
seven hundred and ninety four
