hundred and Ninety four Between George Hansell
of the State of New York Esq. late a Soldier in Col.
Nicolo's Regiment of the one Part And Evander Childs
of the City of New York of the other. Witnesseth that the said
George Hansell for and in Consideration of the sum of
Three Dollars New York Currency to him in hand paid
at the enclosing and delivery of these presents the
Receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged hath granted
bargained sold aliened remised released conveyed
affirmed confirmed and by these presents both
grant bargain sold alien remised released conveyed
confirm assign transfer and set over unto the said
Evander Childs. All his State right title interest and
Property claim and demand of in and to all the
Portions of Lands granted or to be granted to him
pursuant to an Act of the Honorable the Legislature of the
State of Pennsylvania: which said last mentioned Land given
