


KNOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS, That I *Samuel*

 such Pay, Arrears of Pay, Rations, Cloathing, Lands, or Depreciation of Pay, that
 may be due me from the United States or any particular state, for my services render-
 ed as aforesaid, hereby ratifying all that my Attorney or his substitute or substitutes
 shall do therein by virtue hereof.
