and empower my said Attorney to goe in my name
any receipt or receipts or Acquittances for the said
as the my said Attorney may think needful
by the said Attorney and also to ask for
demand out of the State of Pennsylvania or from
the United States for my services he during the
late war and also do authorize and empower
the said Thomas Shelby to sue for and recover for
all any debt that may be due to or received for
my services as a soldier either before or after May and
October and also to sue for and recover my said
Attorney to employ or employ one or more Agents
Attorneys at his pleasure and if so he by
and confirm every Act or Act which my said
Attorney shall or may do in or about the premises
