Personally came before me the subscriber one of the Justices of the Peace for said County Joel Gray and on his solemn Oath taken according to law doth say that he this Deponent first became acquainted with Daniel Newnham as a fellow Soldier in Colonel Thomas Hartley's Regiment, but that Deponent being unfit for Duty and was discharged, and further saith that ~~he~~ that he enquired at several of his fellow Soldiers after the War about the said Daniel Newnham and was told by them all that said Daniel Newnham Died in the Service of the Army, Deponent further saith that Daniel Newnham and himself got furloughs to come to York to see our respective families and that at the time we were in York Deponent knew and became acquainted with said Newnham's Wife & family and knew him to have two Sons Henry Newnham and David Newnham and further knew his eldest son Henry Newnham to be bound to Christian Heikatom Weaver of York town to learn the Weaver Trade, and further saith that the said Henry Newnham now follows his Trade in the Borough of York. and Deponent further saith that he was enlisted as a Soldier during the Revolutionary War and that Daniel Newnham was also enlisted during the war further saith not
