



K NOW ALL MEN BY THESE PRESENTS that *I Charles Oldwine late a soldier in the Pennsylvania Line*

in the Service of the United States for and in consideration of the sum of *to* in hand well and truly paid by *Edward Newton* of the *County of Chester* at and before the sealing and delivery hereof, the receipt whereof *do* hereby acknowledge, have and by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, assign, release, transfer and set over unto the said *Edward Newton* and to his heirs and assigns forever all *my* estate, right, title, interest, use, possession, property, claim and demand whatsoever, which *do* now have or which *my* heirs, executors, or administrators may at any time hereafter have to all and singular the lands, pay, arrearages of pay, to cloathing, rations, gratuities, or other demands due and owing *to me* from the United States, or from any particular State for *my* services as aforesaid. — TO HAVE AND TO HOLD all and singular the above mentioned and assigned premises with the appurtenancies unto him the said *Edward Newton* his heirs and assigns to the only proper use, benefit and behoof of him the said *Edward Newton* his heirs and assigns for ever and do hereby nominate, constitute, and appoint him the said *Edward Newton* his heirs and assigns *my* true and lawful Attorney irrevocable, to ask, demand, recover and receive of and from the United States, or from any particular State, or from any person or persons acting by from or under their or any of their authority, all and singular the said lands, pay, arrearages of pay, rations, gratuities and other demands whatsoever due and owing to *me* as aforesaid, and to receive and accept the same by grant or otherwise in his or their own name or names and to his or their own proper use and behoof forever, and also to sign seal and execute good and sufficient discharges for the same in due form of Law.
