Personally appeared before me an Alderman in and for the City of Lancaster, the said Christian Reinick late of the Borough (now City) of Lancaster who was a Surgeon in the Revolutionary War and died shortly ^{having received wounds at the battle of Brandywine} after the conclusion of the war, at least previous to the year 1780. That he left one living daughter who was his only child named Catharine. That she married a George Zeigler who lived about four miles from this place. That sometime since the year I do not recollect perhaps ten years or more since he moved to Beaver County in this state with his family, that shortly after he returned here and believe on a visit and died in this County.
