and Appurtenances to the hereby bargained  
and sold premises belonging to or in any  
wise appertaining To have and to hold  
The said Tract or piece of Land and premis  
es hereby bargained with the Appurtenances  
unto the said Alexander Power his heirs  
and assigns to the only proper use benefit
