BY THESE PRESENTS, THAT I *Daniel Shehan* late a private soldier in the Pennsylvania line and first Regiment in the service of the United States, do constitute and appoint *Fred. Hollenbeck*

my true and lawful Attorney irrevocably for me and in my name to receive all such pay, rations, cloathing, lands, or depreciation of pay that may be due me from the United States or any particular State, for my services rendered as aforesaid; with power also an attorney or attorneys under him for that purpose to make and substitute and to do all lawful acts, requisite for effecting the premises, hereby ratifying and confirming all my said attorney or his substitute or substitutes shall do therein by virtue hereof. In witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal the *twelfth* day of *March* One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety *three*
