I know all men by these presents That I John Shilling
of the County of Lycoming and State of Pennsylvania have
at a certain day appointed my Trusty friend Saml. E. Grier of
the Town of Williamsport in the said County my Lawful Attorney
to act and do every thing and for my use to file for me and
in my Name to receive any dues, Debts, or Land Comings to me
in any of the Pennsylvania Lands, Preference to said Power
I have made choice of my other Trusty friend Mr. M. Elvee of
my Lawfull attorney in room and stead of Saml. E. Grier to do
and act for me and in my stead as if I was personally present
to ask any lands or title of Patent or patents that may justly
be Coming to me, as by an Act of Assembly Granting the same
to those who served in the Army to the End of the war
Platifying and Confirming, and by these presents allowing what-
soever my said Attorney shall in my name Lawfully do in and
about the premises by virtue of these presents In Witness Whereof
I have hereunto set my hand and Seal this 20th August 1807
