 and in my name and Stead put to the sole use of
 him the said George Carlinger his heirs and assigns
 forever to ask Demand and by all Lawfull means
 Recover and Receive all such Sum or Sums of money
 as well as grants or confirmations ~~lands and tenements~~
 or other demands whatsoever Due unto me by the
 United States or State of Pennsylvania or any other
 Person or Persons acting under their authority and
 I also give and Grant unto my said Attorney full
 Power and absolute authority to sell and Dispose
 of all and singular the Lands Tenements Grantuities
 and Donations which I may be Entitled to or of
 Right may claim in Virtue of any act of the United
 States in Congress assembled or under the authority
 of any act of the State of Pennsylvania for or
 by Reason of my having Served in the said Fifth
 Regiment of the Pennsylvania Line, and by Good
 and Sufficient assistance in the Law to grant convey
 and confirm to the Purchaser or Purchasers the fee Simple
