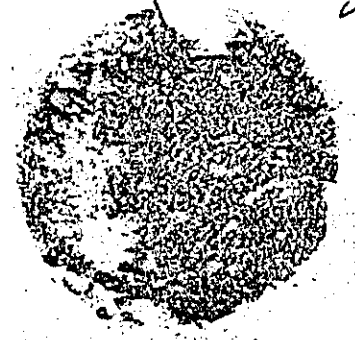


To the Surveyor General or to the Secretary of the Land Office
