Dues or sums of money aforesaid, Acquittances or other  
sufficient discharges, for us and in our name to make  
seal and deliver, and generally all and every other Acts  
and Acts Things and Things Deeds or Deeds in the  
Law whatsoever needful and necessary to be done in
