and sums of money debts goods wares dues accounts and other demands
whosoever which are or shall be due owing payable and belonging to me
or due from me by ~~the~~ ~~means~~ of ways or means whatsoever
by the united States giving and granting unto my said attorney by
these presents my full and whole power strength and authority in and
about the premises to have use and take all lawful ways and means
in my name for the recovery thereof and upon the receipt of any such
debts due or sums of money aforesaid acquittance or other sufficient
receipts for me and in my name to make due and diligent and generally
all and every other act or acts thing and things done and to be done
law whatsoever needful and necessary to be done in and about the premises
for the recovery of all or any such debts or sums of money aforesaid
for me and in my name to do execute and perform as fully largely and
amply to all intents and purposes as I my self might or could do if I was
personally present or as if the matter required more special authority than
is herein given and attorney one or more under him for the purpose
aforesaid to make and constitute and again to substitute
Relieving allowing and holding for firm and effect all and whatsoever
my said attorney shall lawfully do in and about the premises by
virtue hereof in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and
Seal this tenth day of August annoque Domini 1788
