

Know all Men by these Presents that I Patrick Sullivan of Alton Township in the County of Cumberland and State of Pennsylvania and formerly a Soldier in the Tenth Regiment of Pennsylvania and was Discharged the thirty first Day of October 1789 have made ordained and Constituted and by these Presents do Make ordain and constitute and in my Place and stead put John McDonel Esq. of the Militia of Cumberland County and now residing on his Estate in said County my true and lawful Attorney for me and in my Name and for my use to Ask Demand Sue for recover and receive all such Land Deed and other Rightings as may on my Wife's Merits belong or as Due and belonging to me or Detained from me by any Manner of ways or Means whatsoever by the Honorable the Assembly of this State Given and granting unto my said Attorney by these Presents my full and whole Power Strength and Authority in and about Premises to hear use and take all Lawfull ways and Means in my Name for the recovery thereof and upon the Receipt of any such Lands Acquittance or other sufficient Discharges for me and in my Name to Make Seal and Deliver and generally all and every other Act or Acts thing and things Deeds and Devises in the Law whatsoever needful and Necessary to be Done in and about the Premises for the recovery of all or any such Lands Appropiate for me and in my Name to Do Execute and perform as fully and Employed to all intents and purposes as if My self might or could Do if it were lawfully Granted or as if the Matter required more Special Authority than is therein Given and for the purpose of or said to Make and constitute and again at pleasure to revoke Reaffirming Allowing and holding firm and Appertial all and whatsoever my said Attorney shall lawfully Do in and about the Premises by Virtue hereof In Witness whereof I have therunto set my hand and Seal this Nineteenth Day of May in the year one thousand Seven hundred and Eighty Nine
