Parsonaley appeared before me one of the
 Aldermen of said City & J. D. Milbore and he being duly
 sworn according to Law - Depose th and sayeth that he was
 well acquainted with Sergeant Edward Swain from the
 Early part of 77 to the time he was transferred to the Corps
 of Invalides - and also that I knew Mary his wife
 which he names in his will Mary Rockhill to be
 his wife all the war or at Least he owned her
 as such and she was well known in our Brigade
 as Mrs Swain - I also know that she had children
 and that at Least two of them were allowed to
 draw Rations in the 6th Regiment under the Comma
 nd - of Lt Col Jos^{ph} Warner and I further swear
 that the very Mary Rockhill so called in Swains
 will is the very Mrs Swain formerly known by that
 name ^{in our brigade} as to his not giving her the former name
 I know nothing of and further this Deponent sayeth
 not -
