Know Ye, That I William Taggart late a Soldier in the fourth Regiment in the Pennsylvania Line

in the Service of the United States of America, for a valuable Consideration to me in Hand paid by Jacob White of Berk's County at and before the Ensigning and Delivery hereof, the Receipt whereof I do hereby acknowledge, Have granted, bargained, sold, remise, released, quit claimed, transferred and assigned, and by these Presents Do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, quit claim, transfer and assign to the said Jacob White Heirs and Assigns for ever, to his and their proper Use and Benefit, all the Right, Title, Interest, Property, Claim and Demand, hereby authorize my said Attorney irrevocable with full Power to receive, sell and dispose of all and singular the Lands, Tenements, Gratuities and Donations which I am entitled to from the State of Pennsylvania or the United States, for Services by me rendered in the said State, or the United States of America I do hereby appoint said Jacob White my lawful Attorney irrevocable, for a valuable Consideration to me in Hand paid by Jacob White

do hereby acknowledge, Have granted, bargained, sold, released, remise, quit claimed, transferred and assigned, and by these Presents, Do grant, bargain, sell, remise, release, quit claim, transfer and assign to the said Jacob White Heirs and Assigns for ever, all the Right, Title, Interest, Property, Claim and Demand, to all such Pay, Sum or Sums of Money or Certificates, and every other Debt due by the State Pennsylvania or the United States for Services rendered by me due me from the United States of America for my Services, or for Arrearages of Clothing, Rations, Gratuities, Commutations or otherwise howsoever, To have, hold, receive, take and enjoy the said Lands, Monie and other the Premises hereby granted and assigned to the said Jacob White his Heirs and Assigns to his and their proper Use, Benefit and Beboof for ever. I the said William Taggart do hereby further appoint said Jacob White

my true and lawful Attorney irrevocable to receive, sell, assign and transfer all the Stock that may or shall hereafter be standing in my Name or Attornies on the Books of the Register of the Treasury of the United States of America, and for his proper Use, Benefit and Beboof for ever. And I the said William Taggart do hereby covenant and agree, that I, my Heirs, Executors, or Administrators, or any of them, shall and will, at any Time hereafter, at the Request, Cost and Charges of the said William Taggart his Heirs and Assigns, make, sign, seal, and in due Form of Law, execute and acknowledge all and every such reasonable Acts, Things, Conveyances and Assurances in the Law whatsoever, for the more full and perfect Recovery of all such Pay, Sum or Sums of Money or Certificates, due me from the United States of America as aforesaid, and for the Receiving, Transferring and Assigning the same to any Person or Persons whatsoever, as by their Counsel learned in the Law, of him the said Jacob White shall be reasonably advised, devised and required. And I the William Taggart Have made, ordained, constituted, authorized and appointed, and by these Presents Do make, ordain, constitute, authorize and appoint the aforesaid Jacob White my true and lawful Attorney irrevocable for and in my Name, and in my Name and Stead, but for the sole Use and Benefit of him the said Jacob White his Heirs and Assigns, To ask, demand, and by all lawful Means recover and receive all such Pay, Sum or Sums of Money or Certificates, which are due to me from the said State and the United States of America, or any Person or Persons acting under their Authority for my Services or Arrearages of Clothing, Rations, Gratuities, Commutations, or otherwise howsoever, and upon Receipt thereof to pass any requisite Receipt or Acknowledgment for the same. And I do further delegate to him, my said Attorney, full Power and Authority to appoint one or more Attornies under him for the Purpose aforesaid, ratifying and confirming all Acts and Things whatsoever, which my said Attorney or his Substitutes shall or may do in the Premises by Virtue hereof. IN WITNESS whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this Twenty fourth Day of April in the Year of our Lord One Thousand Seven Hundred and Ninety one

And I the William Taggart Have made, ordained, constituted, authorized and appointed, and by these Presents Do make, ordain, constitute, authorize and appoint the aforesaid Jacob White my true and lawful Attorney irrevocable for and in my Name, and in my Name and Stead, but for the sole Use and Benefit of him the said Jacob White his Heirs and Assigns, To ask, demand, and by all lawful Means recover and receive all such Pay, Sum or Sums of Money or Certificates, which are due to me from the said State and the United States of America, or any Person or Persons acting under their Authority for my Services or Arrearages of Clothing, Rations, Gratuities, Commutations, or otherwise howsoever, and upon Receipt thereof to pass any requisite Receipt or Acknowledgment for the same. And I do further delegate to him, my said Attorney, full Power and Authority to appoint one or more Attornies under him for the Purpose aforesaid, ratifying and confirming all Acts and Things whatsoever, which my said Attorney or his Substitutes shall or may do in the Premises by Virtue hereof.
