did see the Testator therein named sign and seal this will, and that
they heard him publish pronounce and declare the same to be his
last will and Testament; that at the time of his so doing he was
to the best of their apprehensions of sound and disposing Mind
Memory and Understanding and that they respectively subscribed their
Names as witnesses to this will, in the Presence and at the Request
of the Testator and in the Presence of each other.
