I Recd your letter by Mr Thomas
Hardy dated Decemr 14th last, wherein you
mention of your getting your land for being
in the army, Thomas tells me it would not be
worth my while to go to Philad. after it
as it would not clear the expence attending
my Journey & getting it out. Therefore
I do hereby authorize you to go to wheresoever
it may be had, and get more and if it comes
to any thing more than what you have to
pay which I understand is 30 or 40 shillings
your money, pay John Pichey 18/9 but
what the Court would over Prun the Purchase
of this you must be best Judge. I sold my
way to Capt. Owens who has my Discharge
when you may get it if it be necessary
get the land out in your name and sell it
to the best advantage you can & come here
as I am sure it will be much better for
you than staying in Philad - your Friend
