

Know all Men by these presents that I Isaac Vogan of Lancaster County and State of Pennsylvania, late Private Soldier in Captain Thomas Boudie's Company of the Fifth Regiment of Pennsylvania, have made ordained authorized and appointed, and by these presents do make Ordain Authorize and Appoint, Thomas Boudie of State and County aforesaid, my true and Lawfull Attorney for me and in my Name and to my Heirs to both demand Draw for and receive the rights of all Donation Lands due by the State of Pennsylvania to me the above named Isaac Vogan late Private Soldier in the Line of Pennsylvania, And to give Acquittance or other sufficient discharge for the same and in my Name fully in every respect as I myself might or could do if I were personally present in Witness whereof I have hereunto set my Hand and Seal this 20th day of November 1798
