

This Indenture Made the Twenty fifth day of January  
in the year of Our Lord One thousand Seven Hundred and  
Ninety Eight by and between Nicholas Harkitt of the County  
of Washington in the State of Pennsylvania of the One part And  
William Hemmons Jun<sup>r</sup> of the County and State aforesaid of  
the other part Witnesseth that for and in consideration of the  
sum of Forty pounds specie to the said Nicholas Harkitt in  
hand paid (before the Execution of this Deed) by the said  
William Hemmons Jun<sup>r</sup> The Receipt whereof is hereby Acknow-  
-ledged and him said William Hemmons thereof forever Acquit-  
-ed and discharged. I the said Nicholas Harkitt have and by  
these presents doth Grant Bargain and Sell, Release Infeoff-  
-Convey and Confirm Unto the said William Hemmons All  
that Tract of Land which was Granted to me for my Services  
in the Late War between the United States and Great Britton  
the same Tract hereby Conveyed is bounded as follows (to wit)  
Beginning at a Stake the Numbered former and running East  
by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 1274 One Hundred and thirty perches to a Stake.  
Thence South by Lot 1272 Two Hundred and sixty one  
perches to a White Oak, Thence West by Vacant Land One  
hundred and thirty perches to a White Oak Thence North  
by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 1276 two hundred and sixty one perches to the  
place of Beginning containing Two Hundred Acres and  
Allowance of 6 1/2 C<sup>t</sup> for Roads &c The same Tract of Land  
is Numbered 1277 in the Sixth District of Donation Land
