 Malgor late Soldier in the Third Pennsylvania Re-
 giment Commanded by Colonel Robert Engle
 and late of the Honorable Congress. Whereas by a Resolution of
 the Honorable Congress passed the day of
 August 1783 granting some Lands to the Officers
 and Soldiers of the United States Army. And
 Whereas the abovesaid Michael Malgor was in-
 listed in the abovementioned Third Pennsylvania
 Regiment for during the late War. And came with
 to some Lands as by the said Resolution of the Ho-
 norable Congress will appear. Now know ye that
 the said Michael Malgor for and in Consideration of
 the sum of fifteen pounds in his to him well and truly
 in and paid by Peter Mengel of the County of York
 in the County of Berks and State of Pennsylvania. He
 at and before the Countrey & Delivery hereof the said Peter
 Mengel his Heirs, Executors, & Administrators. And
 Assigns & forever discharged by their presence. Have
 granted bargained sold & delivered. And by their presence
 doth grant, bargain, sell & deliver unto the said Peter
 Mengel his Heirs & Assigns forever All my Right
 Title & Claim, of the abovementioned Land due me by
 the Stat. of Pennsylvania. To have and to hold
 the said Abovescribed Land unto the said Peter
 Mengel his Heirs & Assigns forever, to the only use
 for Use & behoof of him the said Peter Mengel his
 Heirs & Assigns forever. And further do Assign
 and deliver unto the said Peter Mengel his Heirs & Assigns
 all my say due me by the United States aforesaid. And
 by their presence giving and granting Full Power & Authority
 unto
