Wann of Heidelberg Township in the County of Dauphin  
and in the State of Pennsylvania Yeoman (late a  
Soldier in the 1<sup>st</sup> Pennsylvania Regiment in the Army  
of the United States) Have made ordained constituted  
and appointed and by these Presents Do make ordain  
constitute and appoint Jacob Weirich (now a Member of  
the House of Representatives at Lancaster) my true  
and lawful Attorney for me and in my Name and  
for my Use to require Obtain and procure a Patent  
for all the Lands which I am entitled to get for  
according to Law for my Services as soldier during  
the Revolutionary War in the Army of the United States  
against the Forces of the British King. and likewise  
to obtain a Settlement for me and in my Name and  
for my Use and to receive all my Pay arrearages  
of Pay clothing and other emoluments to which I am  
entitled for my Services aforesaid and upon the receipt  
thereof or of any part thereof to sign a receipt or other  
acquittance for the same. And generally to do and  
perform all other acts and things respecting the same for  
me and in my Name ~~and~~ in as full and ample a  
manner as I myself might or could do if personally  
present or as if ~~the~~ the matter required more special  
authority than is hereby given holding for firm and effect  
whatsoever my said Attorney shall lawfully do or cause to be  
done in and about the Premises by virtue hereof In  
Witness whereof I have herewith set my Hand & Seal the  
10<sup>th</sup> day of March Anno Domini 1805.
