 and receive from the proper officers of the Commonwealth of
 Pennsylvania a patent for such quantity of land as I am
 entitled to claim by virtue of an act of assembly entitled an
 act "for the relief of Daniel Walker" passed during the last
 session of the Legislature, and to do and perform all other
 things in my name and stead that may be necessary to
 obtain the said patent - And whatsoever ~~and whatever~~
 my said attorney shall lawfully do in the premises I
 the said Daniel Walker do hereby confirm and allow as
 fully as if I myself were present and did the same in
 my own name and person In witness whereof I have
 hereunto set my hand and seal April 12th 1806
