Do constitute and appoint my trusty friend Hans Hamilton, to be my true and lawful Attorney to ask demand and recover from the United States, and the State of Pennsylvania, all my right and title of such emoluments of Land as are due from the United States and the State of Pennsylvania in such cases to make of provided, ratifying and confirming whatsoever my said Attorney shall do in the premises. Witness my hand & Seal this 19th day of Sept. 1787
