


Know all Men By these Presents, That I *William Wedderburn* formerly a private in the *25th* *Regt* *Pennsylvania Regiment* *Captain Miller's Company* commanded by *Col William Cook* in the service of the United States of America for value and the full consideration money to me in hand paid, at, and before the execution hereof by *Frederick Molinere* the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, HAVE, and hereby Do grant, bargain, sell, transfer, convey and confirm unto *Frederick Molinere* his heirs, executors, administrators, and assigns for ever, all the right, title and interest whatsoever, in law and equity, which I now have, or which *my* heirs, executors, or administrators, may hereafter have to the lands, pay, depreciation, clothing, rations, rewards, bounties, gratuities, prize-money and other arrearage, claim and demand whatever due and owing *to me* from and by the United States or any particular state, and I do hereby for *myself* my heirs, executors and administrators covenant and agree, to and with the said *Frederick Molinere* his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns that *my* heirs, executors, and administrators, will, at any time hereafter at the reasonable cost and charges of *the said Frederick Molinere* his heirs, executors, administrators or assigns, make, or cause to be made, any future conveyances and assurances in the law, necessary to be done, for the further transferring and confirming, all and singular the premises and claims hereby granted and assigned, or intended so to be. And do make constitute and appoint *the said Frederick Molinere* my true and lawful attorney; irrevocable to demand and receive sue for, and recover from the United States, or any particular State, or any person or persons, acting, by or under their or either of their authority, all and singular the premises, rights, claims, and emoluments herein above recited and sold, and now withheld and detained from *me* by the *United States or the State of Pennsylvania* with power, also attorney or attorneys for that purpose, to make and substitute, and to do all lawful acts requisite for effecting the premises, hereby ratifying and confirming all that *my* said attorney or his substitute or substitutes, shall do therein by virtue hereof.
