-ment during and to the end of the late Revolutionary War, here-
-by enters his caveat against the granting of a Patent to the Heirs
or Representatives of John Nicholson deceased, or to any other
person or persons whomsoever, for his tract of ~~land~~ the Donation
Lands promised by Law to the Officers and Soldiers of the late
Pennsylvania line in the service of the United States, to the
end of the said War; - Alleging that he never sold, disposed
of or ⁱⁿ any manner alienated the same or any part thereof.
