Whereas in consideration of the services rendered by Daniel Birdiead ^{and his wife} in the late Army of the United States, he the said
Birdiead _____ was possessed of a Patent, granting unto him in the name of the Commonwealth a certain Tract of Land in that part of the
Donation Land which is found to lie within the boundaries of the State of New-York.

Now know ye, That in consideration of the surrender of the said Patent, and of a Release or Quit-claim executed by the said James Headland unto the Commonwealth
sation which he the said James Headland might be entitled to on account of his loss by reason of the premises, there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto the said James Headland his Heirs and Assigns, all that certain Tract or Parcel of Land lying in the county of Richmond on the west side of the Muscong River in the
District of Sandston bounded on the west by Long Run, a river, beginning at a point on the numbered corner between the
lot No 48 tract hereof and the lot No 49 tract, thence southwesterly to lot No 50; the said tract and said six parcels is a tract
