

The Supreme Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING :

KNOW YE,

Dailey Serjeant

That in consideration of the services rendered by *Joseph* in the late army of the *United States*

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *Joseph Dailey*

a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*

In the Tenth district of Donation Lands beginning at a Birch Tree the Numbered Corner and running East by Lot or Vacant Land two hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech Tree thence South by Lot N^o. 2082. one hundred sixty two perches and five tenths of a perch to a Beech Tree thence thence West by Lot N^o. 191. two hundred and sixty one perches to an Ash Tree, thence North by Lot or Vacant Land one hundred sixty two perches and five tenths of a perch to the place of beginning Containing Two hundred and fifty Acres and allowance of Six feet for Roads &c. Numbered CXC.

with its appurtenances unto the said *Joseph Dailey* his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Joseph Dailey* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

Joseph Dailey his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges.

IN WITNESS whereof *The Honorable Charles Biddle* Esquire, Vice President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the state seal to be affixed the *twenty fifth* day of *October* in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty *six* and of the commonwealth the *Eleventh*
