WITNESSETH, that the said Joseph Bailey &c; for and in consideration of the sum of Thirty seven Pounds ten shillings &c; unto him in Hand paid by the said Francis Murray &c; at the Time of the Execution hereof, the Receipt whereof the said Joseph Bailey &c; doth hereby acknowledge, HATH and hereby Doth grant, bargain, sell, alien, enfeoff, release, and confirm unto the said Francis Murray his &c; Heirs and Assigns for ever; A certain tract or parcel of land lying in the County of Westmoreland in the tenth District of Navigation lands beginning at a Birch Tree the Number of former and running East by lot or vacant land Two hundred and forty one perches to a Beech Tree thence South by lot N. 2083 One hundred forty two perches and four tenths of a perch to a Birch Tree thence West by lot N. 191 two hundred and sixty one perches to an old Tree thence North by lot or vacant land One hundred forty two perches and five tenths of a perch to the place of beginning containing Two hundred and fifty acres and Allowance of six Pounds for Roads & Numbered CXC] being the upper Tract of land which the Commonwealth aforesaid by their Letters Patent under the Hand of the Honourable Charles Bidle Esquire Vice President and State Seal bearing date the twenty fifth day of October One thousand seven hundred and eighty six duly examined and granted unto the said Joseph Bailey in the same and by the said recited Patent more fully appears]

together with all and singular the Ways, Woods, Waters, Water-Courses, Rights, Liberties, Privileges, Advantages, Hereditaments, and Appurtenances whatsoever, unto the said hereby granted Premises belonging, and the Reversions and Remainders, Rents, Issues and Profits thereof, and also all the Estate, Right, Title, and Interest whatsoever, both in Law and Equity, of the said Joseph Bailey &c; of, into, and out of the same, or any Part thereof: TO HAVE AND TO HOLD, the said described Tract, or Parcel of Land, Hereditaments and Premises hereby granted with the Appurtenances unto the said Francis Murray his &c; Heirs and Assigns: To and for the only proper use and behoof of the said Francis Murray his &c; Heirs and Assigns for ever. And the said Joseph Bailey &c; and his Heirs, all and singular the said hereby granted Premises, and every Part thereof, with the Appurtenances, unto the said Francis Murray his Heirs and Assigns, against him the said Joseph Bailey &c; and his Heirs, and against all and all Manner of Person and Persons whatsoever, lawfully claiming or to claim by from or under him them or any of them shall and will warrant and for ever defend by these Presents.
