

To all to whom these Presents shall come, Greeting:


Know ye, That in consideration of the services rendered by John Evans private _____ in the late Army of the United States and in the
Pennsylvania Line _____ there is granted by the said Commonwealth unto the said John Evans a certain tract of land No. 250 called London
derry Situate in Conestoga district No. 2 Berks County Beginning at a black Oak thence by vacant land
thence hundred thirty perches to a white oak thence by lot No. 255 West, two hundred sixty one perches to a white Oak thence
lot No. 273, South one hundred thirty perches to a Post; and thence by lot No. 257 East two hundred sixty one perches to the
beginning containing Two hundred Acres and Allowance of six ff Cent for roads &c. Which said tract was surveyed
pursuance of an Act of the General Assembly passed the 21st February 1785.

give and to hold the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances, unto the said John Evans and his Heirs to the use of him the said John Evans
Heirs and Assigns for ever.

free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to Mines, Royalties, Quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all Gold and
Ore for the use of this Commonwealth, to be delivered at the Pitt's mouth, clear of all charges. In Testimony whereof, I have set my Hand, and caused the Great Seal of the State to be affixed to these
docs, at Lancaster this tenth day of November in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred three and of the Commonwealth the twenty-eighth.
