

The Supreme Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania.

To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING :

KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by *The Reverend David Jones Chaplain* in the late army of the United States there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *David Jones* a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*

in the tenth District of Donation of Lands Beginning at a Sugar the numbered corner, Beginning East by Lot N^o 192 Two hundred and sixty one perches to a Sugar, thence South by Lot N^o 202 One hundred ninety five perches to a Beech, thence West by Lot N^o 196 Two hundred and sixty one perches to a Sugar, thence North by Lot N^o 192 One hundred and ninety five perches to the place of Beginning containing Three hundred Acres of allowance of six per cent for roads &c. Numbered XCVII

with its appurtenances unto the said *David Jones* his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the

said *David Jones* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

David Jones his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and

reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth

part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth

clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *The Honorable Charles Brooke*

Esquire, vice President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused

the state seal to be affixed the *twelfth* day of *October* in the year of our Lord one
