To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

KNOW YE,

Kenn Soldier

That in consideration of the services rendered by *John McKenn*

in the late army of the *United States*,

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *John McKenn*

a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*
in the tenth District of *Bentonian Lands*, Beginning at a Beech tree numbered Council
running East by ~~south~~ ^{vacant} land Five hundred and forty one perches to a Sycamore, thence South
by E^E 1/2 N^N 19° 48' One hundred and thirty perches to a Beech, thence West by S^S 1/2 E^E 19° 60' Thence
~~South~~ ^{South} and sixty one perches to a Sycamore, thence North by E^E 1/2 N^N 19° 62' One hundred and thirty
perches to the place of Beginning continuing Six hundred acres and a distance of six perches
for Roads, & Fumigated MDCCCLXI.

with its appurtenances unto the said *John McKenn* his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the
said *John McKenn* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

John McKenn his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *The Honourable Charles Biddle*

Esquire, *the President of the Supreme Executive Council*, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused
the state seal to be affixed the twenty fourth day of *October* — in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and eighty six and of the commonwealth the *Eleventh*.
