

The Supreme Executive Council of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania,

To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING :

**KNOW YE,** That in consideration of the services rendered by *Stephen Moylan* Esquire Colonel of a Troop of Cavalry, in the late army of the United States there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *Stephen Moylan*

a certain tract or parcel of land, lying in the county of Westmoreland  
In the seventh district of donation Lands beginning at a Black Oak the Numbered  
Corner and running East by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 121 three hundred and twenty six and a Quarter per-  
ches to a Decch Tree thence South by Vacant Land two hundred and sixty perches to a  
post, thence West by district N<sup>o</sup> 6 three hundred and twenty one and a quarter perches to  
a No. 4 White Oak, thence North by Lot N<sup>o</sup> 128 two hundred and sixty perches to the  
place of beginning containing five Hundred Acres and allowance of Six p Cent for  
Roads &c. Numbered CXX.

with its appurtenances, unto the said *Stephen Moylan* — his heirs and assigns forever :

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the  
said *Stephen Moylan* — his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

*Stephen Moylan* — his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and  
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents, or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth  
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth  
clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *The Honorable Charles Biddle*

the State seal to be affixed, the *twelfth* day of *July* in the year of our Lord one
