To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING :

KNOW YE, That in consideration of the services rendered by William Scott in the late army of the United States there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said William Scott

In the tenth district of donation Lands beginning at a Sugar Tree the numbered corner and running East by Lot No 2093 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Sugar Tree thence South by Lot No 2115 one hundred and thirty perches to an Ironwood Tree thence West by Lot No 2093 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Sugar Tree thence North by Lot No 2093 one hundred and thirty perches to the place of beginning containing Two Hundred Acres of Six Per Cent for Roads &c Numbers M M X C I V

with its appurtenances unto the said William Scott his heirs and assigns forever TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said William Scott his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said William Scott his heirs and assigns forever; free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof The Honorable Charles Biddle Esquire, Vice President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the state seal to be affixed the thirtieth day of March in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty seven and of the commonwealth the Eleventh
