KNOW YE, That in consideration of the services rendered by Elias Williams

the second District of the Donation Lands Beginning at an Ash the numbered corner and running South by Lot N^o 1800 Two hundred and sixty perches to a white Oak thence East by Lot N^o 1801 One hundred and eighty seven perches to a post and Ash thence North by Lot N^o 1802 Two hundred sixty one perches to a post and Ash thence West by Lot N^o 1803 One hundred and eighty seven perches to the place of Beginning containing Two hundred and fifty Acres and allowance of six perches for a road year numbered CLXXXIII

with its appurtenances, unto the said Elias Williams _____ his heirs and assigns forever :

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said Elias Williams _____ his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

Elias Williams _____ his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges.
