To all to whom these Presents shall come, GREETING:

KNOW YE,

That in consideration of the services rendered by *Elias Williams* *Sergeant* in the late army of the United States there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said Elias Williams —

a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of Westmoreland. In the second District of the Donation Lands Beginning at an Ash the numbered corner and running South by lot N^o. 1800 Two hundred and six such perches to half to a White Oak thence East by lot N^o. 181 One hundred and eighty seven perches to a post and Ash thence North by lot N^o. 182 One hundred and sixty one such half perches to a post and Ash thence West by lot N^o. 182 One hundred and eighty seven perches to the place of Beginning containing Two hundred and fifty Acres and all unav^g six tenths of an acre. with its appurtenances, unto the said *Elias Williams* his heirs and assigns forever : TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *Elias Williams* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said *Elias Williams* his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *The Honorable Charles Biddle* Esquire, Vice President of the Supreme Executive Council, hath hereunto set his hand, and caused the state seal to be affixed the *twelfth* day of *January* in the year of our Lord one thousand seven hundred and eighty-seven, and of the commonwealth the *Eleventh*
