That in consideration of the services rendered by *William Webb, Private* in the late army of the *United States*

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *William Webb* a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*

*In the tenth district of donation Lands. Beginning at a Black Oak the Numbered Corner and running East by Lot N. 2125 two hundred and sixty one perches to an Elm Tree, thence South by Lot N. 2134 one hundred and thirty perches to a Sugar Tree, thence West by Lot N. 2127 two hundred and sixty one perches to a Beech Tree, thence North by Lot N. 2111 one hundred and thirty perches to the place of beginning, containing two hundred Acres and Allowance of sixt Cent for Roads. Numbered MMCXXVI.*

with its appurtenances unto the said *William Webb*

his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the said *William Webb*

his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

*William Webb*

his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and

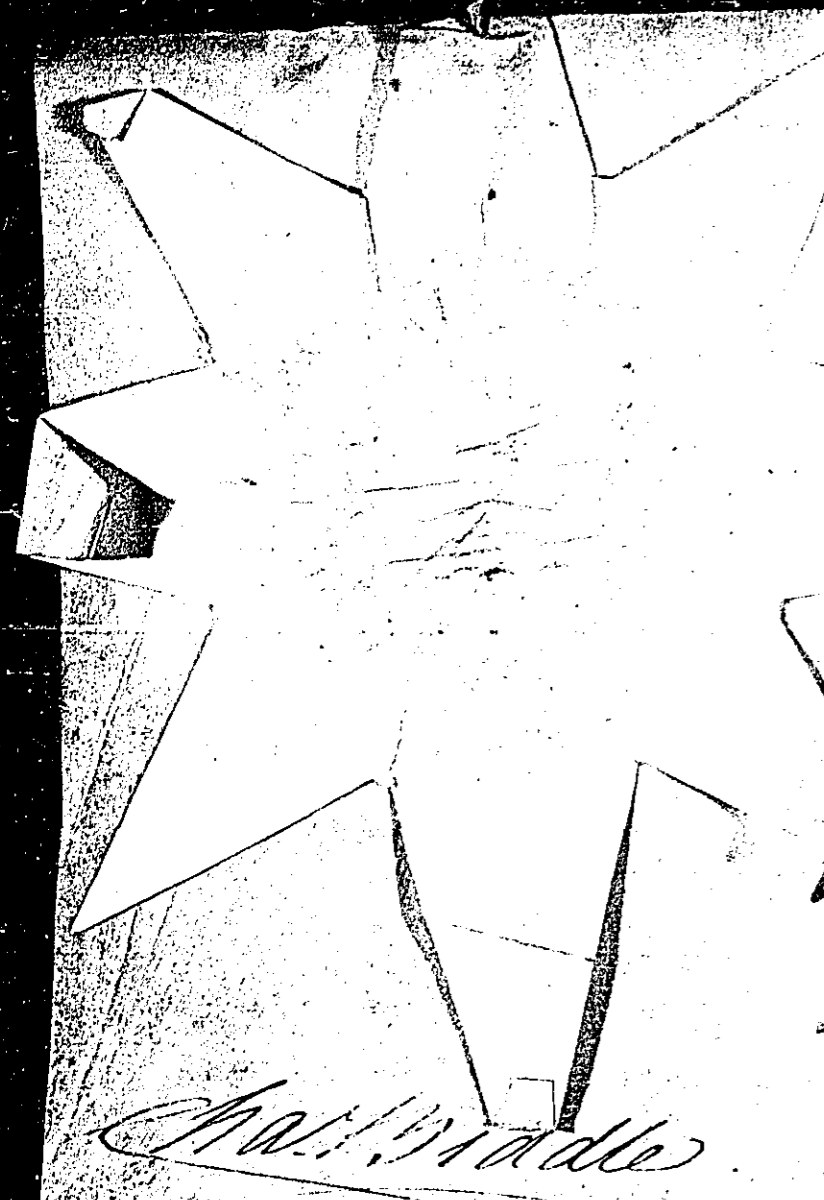
