To all to whom these Presents shall come GREETING:

KNOW YE,

Wally R. Wally

That in consideration of the services rendered by *Michael*

in the late army of the United States

there is granted by the said commonwealth unto the said *Michael Wally*
a certain tract or parcel of land lying in the county of *Westmoreland*

In the tenth district of donations lands beginning at a Buck Tree the numbered corner
and running east by Lot N^o 2144 one hundred and Sixty one perches to an Ash Tree, thence
south by Lot N^o 2150 one hundred and thirty perches to a Beech Tree, thence west by Lot N^o 2142
two hundred and fifty one perches to a Birch Tree, thence North by Lot N^o 2144 one hundred
and thirty perches to the place of beginning containing two hundred and nineteen
acres six pence for Roads by Numbered MM CXLIII

with its appurtenances unto the said *Michael Wally* his heirs and assigns forever:

TO HAVE AND TO HOLD the said tract or parcel of land, with the appurtenances thereof, unto the
said *Michael Wally* his heirs and assigns, to the proper use and behoof of the said

Michael Wally his heirs and assigns forever, free and clear of all restrictions and
reservations as to mines, royalties, quit-rents or otherwise, excepting and reserving only the fifth
part of all gold and silver ore for the use of this commonwealth, to be delivered at the pit's mouth
clear of all charges. IN WITNESS whereof *The Honorable Charles Biddle*

the state seal to be affixed the *sixth* day of *December* in the year of our Lord one
thousand seven hundred and eighty six and of the commonwealth the *Eleventh*
