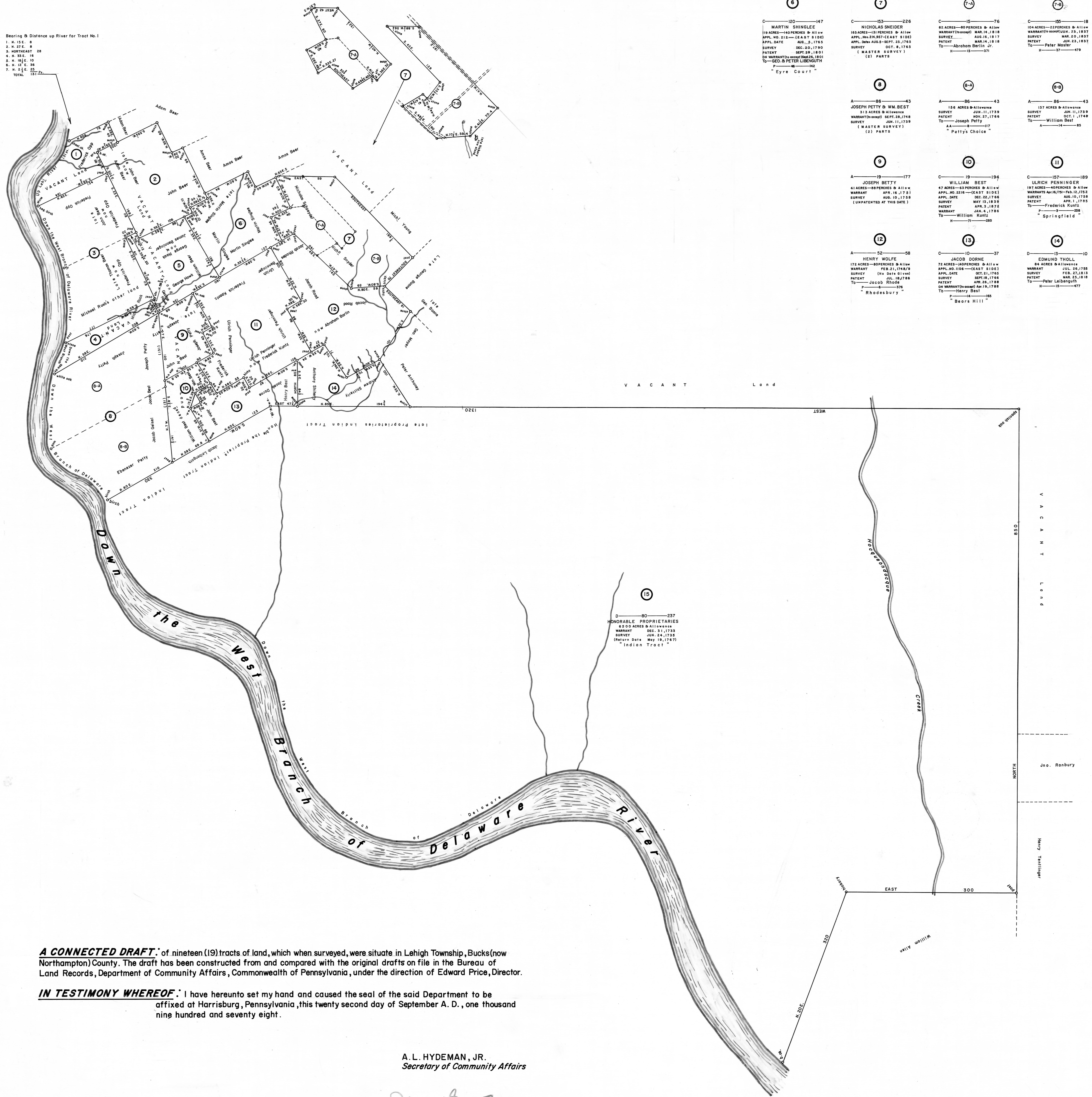


Bearing & Distance up River for Tract No. 1
